Entry Requirements

Enrolment for our foundational First Aid training programme is generally accessible to all interested parties. The key requirements are that candidates must be 16 years or older and possess sufficient literacy skills to follow the theoretical instruction and successfully complete the required assessments in English. Furthermore, participants should be physically able to demonstrate the practical components of the training

Purpose of the Programme

The purpose of the Basic Emergency First Aid Responder qualification is to equip learners to safely assess emergency scenes and competently apply intermediate first aid techniques for medical, trauma, and environmental incidents, ensuring effective scene management until professional help is available.

A qualified learner will be able to:

- **Conduct incident scene safety** and patient assessment within their scope of practice.
- **Provide basic emergency first aid** care and secondary assessments for life-threatening conditions.
- **Apply continuous basic emergency** first aid to mitigate pain and facilitate healing. Safely hand over the treated person to the next level of medical care with associated documentation.
- **Communicate effectively with affected persons**, bystanders, and stakeholders.
- **Conduct post-incident clean-up and reporting**
