The purpose of the Intermediate Emergency First Aid Responder qualification is to equip learners to safely assess emergency scenes and competently apply intermediate first aid techniques for medical, trauma, and environmental incidents, ensuring effective scene management until professional help is available.

### A qualified learner will be able to:

- **Ensure scene safety** and perform initial emergency assessment.
- **Apply intermediate first aid** for common medical and trauma incidents.
- **Manage the emergency scene** effectively until relieved by professional services.
- **Accurately report incident details.**
