Purpose of the Qualification

The primary purpose of the Store Person qualification is to equip learners to efficiently move, pack, pick, and maintain stock in a storage area.

A qualified learner will be able to:

- **Move and pack stock** using specific, safe methods and equipment appropriate for different types of inventory.
- **Pick and count stock** accurately within a stock storage area, ensuring inventory records are maintained.
- **Maintain a safe and organised stock storage area** by adhering to housekeeping and safety protocols.

Knowledge Modules (9 Credits)

Curriculum and Module Breakdown

The qualification consists of three compulsory components aligned with QCTO standards to ensure comprehensive skills development and the benefits of a structured learnership:

1. Knowledge Component
2. Practical Skills Component
3. Work Experience Component
